There were 24 participants from Ankara, İstanbul, Çankırı, Yozgat, Konya, Bursa, İzmit and Eskişehir. Second one was in Mardin for South-East Anatolia Region Training was between 28th-30th September. There were again 24 participants from Mardin, Diyarbakır, Adıyaman, Kilis, Şırnak, Siirt and Şanlıurfa. Third local advocacy training was in Trabzon for Blacksea Region between 5th – 7th October. There were 21 participants from Bayburt, Bartın, Sinop, Samsun, Trabzon and Tokat.

They created action teams in each local youth platform to work in activities. They presented the campaign to their platforms, city councils, and their local governments.• Executive council of National Youth Parliament discussed about A Youth Story Activities in their online meetings and members of executive council supported local activities for their region.• After the local trainings A Youth Story campaign appeared on the press for 4 times. One of them was in Aktuel online newspaper, the other was in online Tokat newspaper, Yerleşke 2023 and last one was in Samsun Haber newspaper. The news were about the project partners, aims of the project, local trainings and local activities.
